## BETHEL TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY RESOLUTION NO. 2008 - 27

At a duly constituted meeting of the Board of directors of the Bethel Township Municipal Authority on the date set forth below,

Upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, it was RESOLVED:

- (1) That the owner(s) of each residential property which was in existence on February 28, 2008, and which property is within the areas designated for public sewer service by Bethel Township and the Department of Environmental Protection in the Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan, and/or which property is adjoining or adjacent to, or if any portion of the principal building is within 150 feet of the sewer collection lines, shall be required to connect to the new sewer systems being constructed by Bethel Township Municipal Authority ("BTMA"), and each such residential property will receive a credit in the amount of \$6,000.00 to be applied to the tapping fee, provided that such residential property is connected in accordance with the time limitations established by BTMA; and
- That the owner(s) of each nonresidential property which was in existence on February 28, 2008, and which property is within the areas designated for public sewer service by Bethel Township and the Department of Environmental Protection in the Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan, and/or which property is adjoining or adjacent to, or if any portion of the principle building is within 150 feet of the sewer collection lines, shall be required to connect to the new sewer systems being constructed by Bethel Township Municipal Authority ("BTMA"),

and each such nonresidential property must pay one-half (1/2) of the \$6,000.00 tapping fee previously established by Resolution of BTMA, in the amount of \$3,000.00 at the time of connection of the nonresidential property to the system, and BTMA will waive one-half (1/2) of the tapping fee (\$3,000.00); provided that such nonresidential property is connected in accordance with the time limitations established by BTMA; and; and

- That every separate residential building, every separate nonresidential building, (3) every separate mixed-use building, and every separate lot, which is connected to the BTMA sewer systems, shall be connected directly to the BTMA sewer line though a separate, individual (non-shared) sewer lateral; and
- Each separate residential or nonresidential use upon a lot, and each separate (4) residential or nonresidential use within a building, including all dwelling units, whether single-family, two-family, duplex, half-doubles, multi-family, dwellings, townhouse, apartments, or any other arrangement of space for occupancy, shall pay a separate sewage rental/treatment rate in the amount established from time to time by Resolution of the Board of Directors of BTMA.
